THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make two Orders under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose No Waiting at Any Time on part of Choyce Close, Coalville
- 2. To impose No Waiting at Any Time on part of Shortheath Road, Moira**
